Objective : To provide immediate emergency relief to the people of Haiti during a tragic natural disaster. The challenge for all first responders was the ability to locate and supply the required relief items at the quantities required by the program, as well as providing these items at the lowest possible cost and quickest turnaround time.

First Response Quotes : IPA issued full quotations within 24 hours of receiving the first request. This fast turnaround time, along with competitive pricing allowed our client to act quickly sending aid to those in need. As the relief efforts progress and needs continue to change, IPA continues to supply quotes and goods for the rebuilding of Haiti.

Relief Goods Supplied : 3,000 Bars Antibacterial Deodorant Soap; 69,000+ Feminine Hygiene Products; 30,000+ Toothbrushes; 6,000+ Tubes of Toothpaste; 14,000+ Individual Bath Towels; 8,000+ Bars of Laundry Soap

Supply Chain & Logistics : All items were consolidated at the program’s consolidation warehouse in Miami to coordinate the shipment of all items at one time. Due to the urgency of the situation, the order was expedited and updates were sent frequently to keep to program up-to-date on the shipment status. The time between the initial request and delivery to the program’s warehouse was an incredible turnaround time of only 2 weeks.

Support & Aftersales : We continue to provide relief items, as well as office infrastructure, to the program as their needs continue to change during the duration of the relief and rebuilding efforts.
