The objective of this project was to provide the Federal Agency in Addis Ababa with a French Door to be used for ongoing renovation projects.



Planning: IPA has supplied a variety of construction materials to Federal Agency in Addis Ababa, to aid in the renovation of local buildings. For this specific project, we reviewed the requested French doors and sought manufacturers capable of meeting the required specifications.



Procurement: IPA researched multiple door options, ranging from material and size, to style and function. We provided the client with available selections that met their specifications, enabling them to choose the best solution for their program. Considering the size requirements and client preferences, we ultimately determined that it was necessary to purchase a custom door.



Pre-Shipment Services: IPA received the door at our crating facility for inspection and packaging. Upon completing our quality control assessment, the door was measured and fitted for custom crating. The crate was tailored with foam inserts to absorb impact and handles were installed for ease of transport. Given the size and fragility of the door, IPA offered a custom logistical solution to ensure safe delivery to the end user.



After-Sales Support: IPA follows up after delivery to ensure the consignment was received in good order, address any concerns, and support manufacturer warranty coverage if necessary. Throughout the year, IPA works closely with the Federal Agency to source and deliver customized goods for a variety of unique projects.
