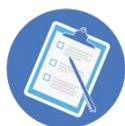

Procurement: IPA has procured a variety of agriculture and environment equipment including: water testing equipment, soil augers, brocap traps, densitometers, and seeders. We attentively review requested equipment lists and research various product options that best suit program requirements. In order to maximize the available budget, we assess fair market prices, negotiate volume discounts, and consider global sourcing options whenever possible.



Pre-Shipment Services: IPA inspects all equipment to ensure compliance with our high standards for quality control because we recognize the importance of getting the correct equipment to the field at the accurate quantity. This preventative approach allows us to minimize errors prior to shipping, that would otherwise result in costly returns and replacements after global delivery.
