Objective : Provision of Trek Bicycles and related spares / accessories for each bike.

Needs Assessment : IPA has partnered with the Agency and Trek for over 25 years. IPA provides the Agency with bicycles for their volunteers and spares parts to maintain their fleets.

Equipment & Supplies : Trek Bicycles, Associated Bike Spares / Accessories. IPA also creates custom spare parts kits personalized to meet the variety of demands for each post location.

Supply Chain & Logistics : IPA offers a tailored supply chain with combination of consolidation of equipment in warehouses, export packaging and shipment of equipment to final destination. Shipping methods include Diplomatic Pouch Facility (for smaller spare parts / accessories), Air Freight (for larger spare parts / accessories) and Sea Freight (for full container shipments of bikes and spares parts / accessories) which includes inland transportation to several African destinations. Status updates and 24/7 via web portal allow Peace Corps to download and print necessary documents for each shipment.

Support & Aftersales : IPA facilitates manufacturer warranty coverage and provides replacement bike spares / accessories. Through our years of experience, IPA provides spare parts to meet the needs of aging fleets, as well as recommends new models when Posts are ready to upgrade.
