IPA worked with the international federal agency to source and distribute information technology to multiple end-user destinations via numerous modes of transportation.



Planning: In the initial planning stage, IPA examined the federal agency's requested list of items. Upon further research, it was determined some of the original items were unavailable. Therefore, in an effort to accommodate the client's needs, IPA found suitable alternatives to fit the requirements of local field offices. Once products were determined, IPA created a brochure for USAID's review and approval, thus ensuring that the products met their standards.



Administrative Operations: For this project, the international federal agency needed their commodities delivered via three separate modes of transportation. IPA was able to take on all administrative burdens to ensure the appropriate documentation was completed for each shipping method. Not only was IPA able to complete all required documentation, but IPA was able to provide status updates to the federal agency to maintain structure and organization.



Pre-Shipment Services: Due to this project having large quantities of IT, as well various required shipping methods, IPA brought all products into our on-site consolidation warehouse. Our warehouse was able to use their quality control methods to inspect the items and assure that the quantities were accurate, and that the manufactures sent exactly what was promised.



Logistical Solutions: The international federal agency requested that IPA ship this order via three modes of transportation to two separate country locations. Once all items had been assessed for quality, IPA researched the regulations for the different logistical options, and we consolidated and packed the items according to restrictions. IPAs specialized in detailed projects, and we were able to create all necessary export documents and orchestrate the logistics, customs clearance, and delivery of the products for all three shipments going to various locations.
