Project objective: Supply and deliver water filter / distiller systems to the International federal agency posts along with the consumables required to successfully provide clean drinking water to volunteers.



Planning: In addition to the water filters and distillers provided to the federal agency posts, IPA routinely supplies replacement filters, hardware and cleaning supplies for all supplied equipment. These consumables help to ensure each apparatus is operating at the highest efficiency to make each volunteer is drinking the cleanest water possible.



Pre-Shipment Services: As the water filters, distillers and various supplies are often shipped in master cartons from the manufacturers, IPA's warehouse ensures all manufacturer packaging is intact prior to dispatching from our warehouse.



Logistical Solutions: Due to each international federal agency post having different requirements, IPA takes additional time when a request is received to determine the best shipping method for each project. As the shipments vary in size, it is imperative to utilize the most economical shipping method to ensure budgets are being efficiently utilized.
